MISSION TRIP

AFRICA

Our Global Ehsan Relief team was in Tanzania, Africa in March 2019. We managed to distribute food aid sets to needy families and children there. Every day, the villagers go out and search for food in the woods; mostly surviving on maize and kasavas (tapioca). For the first time in months, they were able to eat rice.

The food aid sets comprising of rice, flour, maize, cooking oil, sugar, tea, and macaroni were distributed in this remote village. They provided food and nutrition for almost 300 women, children and the elderly. Each food pack can support them for a month.





In the village of Luye in Tanga, Tanzania, we also distributed bicycles. These children had to walk 5km to reach school every day. Half of them did not even have proper shoes, and others walked barefooted as they were unable to afford shoes.

We distributed 50 bicycles to the most needy students who lived farthest from school. It was a huge relief to these children.

The distribution was part of a series in a programme that is benefiting thousands of poor and vulnerable families, the homeless, and children in the conflict-ridden country. Together with the help of our partners, Global Ehsan Relief was able to help prepare and distribute school breakfasts to 200 poor & needy children in Sana'a, Yemen, over 2 months, plus family food packs, blankets and clothing and water trucks providing clean and safe drinking water to households.



Distribution of coats and shoes to 500 youngsters at Al-Ta'awen School in Sana'a. With the cessation of violence and conflict there, we were able to mobilise and distribute 500 food aid sets to 500 desperate families. Your contributions have helped feed over 2500 people who have been struggling to find food for their families and children.



Another major problem faced by the community there is the lack of access to clean, drinkable water. Due to the conflict recently, most infrastructures were either damaged or no longer functional. We were able to provide 14 truckloads of clean water to 70 vulnerable families in Sana'a.



100 blankets were distributed to the homeless people and families in Sana'a City. These people were not forgotten nor left out from our aid program.



EMERGENCY RELIEF

PALU

This was our 4th round of humanitarian aid in Palu and Donggala. We managed to deliver food aid, clean water supply, as well as sweets and tidbits for Kindness Day to help the children recover from trauma, and help with the reconstruction of the mosque. We also assisted with their livelihood program to replace motor boats which were destroyed during the tsunami last year.

On December 22nd, an unexpected tsunami occurred following the eruption of Anak Krakatau. We went over to deliver emergency aid to thousands of displaced people there. In Kampung Pagulon, the villagers were living in a small makeshift shelter.

Despite the hardships they faced, they all rallied together to help each other. They also assisted in cooking meals at the community kitchen we helped set up - providing daily meals, 3 times a day for 150 adults and children.

WATER WELLS & ABLUTION PLACES

One of the biggest challenges faced by developing countries that suffer from poverty, famine or drought is the lack of access to clean water for drinking, sanitation purposes and ablution.

Water is essential to life, yet millions of people, particularly those living in third world countries have little to no access to it.

It is hard to find clean water in countries such as Cambodia, Sri Lanka, Myanmar, and Bangladesh, where water is often extremely polluted.

In areas where land is arid or there is a lack of water resources, Global Ehsan Relief provides communities with access to clean water by building water wells and ablution places.
