COMMUNITY WATER WELL

Our Community Water Wells project has also received a good response and 13 are built in Cambodia. Each water well can be shared with at least 5 families, and 520 people are benefiting from it.

MOSQUE

The people in Toul Srolave Village in Cambodia are now able to pray in congregation in the newly built Wakaf Masjid Yusof Abu Bakar.

Before the establishment, plenty of communities in the province area struggle to find a place to pray. Often, they pray in Masjid or Surau that are about to collapse.

Through your donations, 150 families in the rural area are now able to function as a community.

The Masjid is not only a place for praying, but it's also the center of education, social welfare and dispute settlement.

The new mosque creates opportunity for a community development through reinforcing morality, devotion, knowledge and brotherhood relationship.

COVID-19 FOOD AID DISTRIBUTION 613 Sets Distributed / 3,065 Beneficiaries

Indonesia: 93 Sets
Sri Lanka: 400 Sets
Malaysia: 120 Sets

These food packs serve as a temporary relief for the recipients so that affected families may have food supply for a month. In tough, uncertain times, they need all the aid they can get.

Food aid sets were distributed to the poor, elderly, and widows in rural villages in Sri Lanka. Items include rice, wheat, onions, dhaal, sugar and others.

In Indonesia, 60 honorary teachers and 33 small traders were recipients of the food aid set which includes non-perishable food items that can feed a family of 4.

The package includes 5kg of rice, 1kg of sugar, 1kg of cooking oil, 1 can of milk, 1 pack of biscuits, 1 pack of rice noodles.

A total of 120 food aid sets were distributed to needy families at our GER Malaysia office in Johor Bahru and in Perak.

One pack includes rice, cooking oil, flour, sugar, biscuits, noodles, instant noodles, condensed milk, tea, soy sauce, chilli sauce, cordial, and Milo.

COVID-19 MEALS DISTRIBUTION

With people losing jobs due to national lockdowns, meals were becoming more scarce each day for many people.

GER worked with partners and teams on the ground to provide relief for those affected.

We distributed a total of 11,710 meals in 4 countries, mainly to essential workers, orphans, needy children, and refugees.

COVID-19 BREAD DISTRIBUTION

10,000 Breads Distributed

5,000 Beneficiaries

Bread is a staple food for the Syrians. Having access to their basic food needs helps them to get through troubling times.

With the assistance of international NGO partners, 10,000 breads were given out to Syrian refugees in Azaz, Syria. Each family received a pack of 10 breads, thus benefiting 100 families.

COVID-19 ESSENTIALS

500 Items Distributed / 500 Beneficiaries
Malaysia: 500 Mask and Shield

Face masks and hand sanitizers are precious commodities during a pandemic.

As a result, they come at exorbitant prices, not allowing the poor to have them and increasing their risk of virus transmission.

GER Malaysia also stepped in to provide 500 face masks and face shields to the frontliners at HSA Johor Bahru to fill in the shortage of supplies.

COVID-19 HYGIENE KITS DISTRIBUTION

400 Kits Distributed / 2,000 Beneficiaries



Even refugees or Internally Displaced People (IDP) camps are not safe from the outbreak.

Global Ehsan Relief, with the help of our partners, distributed a total of 400 hygiene kits, which benefitted 2,000 people.

The kits mainly contain soap, detergent, sanitisers, masks, gloves, personal cleaning kits, baby diapers, and shower gels.

And for some kits, it includes antiseptic soap, soap package, detergent, washing powder, wet wipes and towel so as to cater to the people's current needs.

The pandemic has resulted in unprecedented outcomes such as closure of businesses, children missing school, and losing jobs.

To ease this difficult transition for those affected, GER Malaysia gave a cash handout of RM50 to 150 of the beneficiaries that were affected by loss of wages.

GER Singapore also reached out to 20 families consisting of widows, single parents, the disabled, and the elderly, and those who lost their jobs. They received \$200 in cash and a \$50 grocery voucher.

COVID-19 BLANKET & MATTRESS 100 Sets Distributed / 100 Beneficiaries

Resting at home in the comfort of a warm, snug bed is not the case for most of the people in Gaza.

Hence, we stepped in to provide them with tools that can provide them comfort in their homes.

100 blankets and 100 mattresses were distributed to the most needy, as well street cleaners who have been working tirelessly and exposed to the public.



SEASONAL PROJECTS

RAMADAN

Ramadhan this year was exceptionally difficult. Millions of people are under lockdown due to the COVID-19 measures implemented, and food is almost inaccessible especially in less developed countries.

Together with our partners, we strived to help as many as possible to have a meal in a day and break their fast. On Eid, we distributed zakat, gifts and meals. All in all, 48,325 individuals have benefitted from our Ramadan and Eid distribution this year.

Over 5,512 food aid sets have benefitted orphans, widows, and refugees in 20 countries. The food aid was timely as many were affected by a lockdown, and food could become scarce as the global supply chain is interrupted. This aid could sustain them for at least 1 month for each family.



SEASONAL PROJECTS

RAMADAN SAHUR MEALS DISTRIBUTION 350 Meals Distributed / 350 Beneficiaries

Singapore migrant workers under quarantine do not have the luxury of planning and cooking their own meals for sahur.

GER Singapore provided meals for them to ease their fasting.

RAMADAN PRAYER CLOTHES DISTRIBUTION 250 Garments Distributed / 250 Beneficiaries

Aceh: 150 Garments
Cambodia: 100 Prayer Garments

100 prayer garments were distributed to female villagers in Samroung village in Takeo province, Cambodia.

Another 250 sets of prayer garments were given to poor muallaf in Singkil, Aceh.

Singkil is a small island located between the border of Aceh and South Sumatra.

These are two rural areas dwelled by poor, needy communities who do not have access to amenities that can ease their daily worship. This distribution aims to ease that process.



SEASONAL PROJECTS

EID

This year Eid-ul-fitr was unlike any other with major lockdowns across the globe.

We may not be able to follow the Sunnah practices for instance joining in the congregational Eid prayers in a mosque.

However, we can still reap its blessing and share our Eid with everyone across the globe.

We distributed hot meals, eid gifts as well as zakat donations to the respective beneficiaries.

In Singapore, 480 migrant workers and 200 people from underprivileged families savour traditional hot cooked meals distributed to them on the day of Eid.

Kindness Day is a signature event done every month by local GER offices with the simple main objective to show a kind gesture to others.

At every event, we distribute free food or items to the public to share smiles, conversations, and acts of kindness.

This event is made possible each month thanks to the donations and contributions of donors and sponsors. We are able to provide simple treats and gifts to the community.

SCHOOL KITS

Aceh, Indonesia

54 Kits Distributed / 54 Beneficiaries

Books and stationery were distributed to 54 poor and needy students in Dayah Khamsatu Anwar to support their education. This mahad is located in Aceh Besar where most of its students live in poverty.

COVID-19 has made it hard for their parents to cover their monthly study fees, food and stationery for the new school semester.

With the school kits, they are equipped with the tools they need to study.



OTHER PROJECTS

EHSAN BABY CARE

19 Packages Distributed / 19 Beneficiaries

Some parents are struggling to make ends meet and to provide the basic necessities for their babies. To ease their burdens, GER SG provides one care package for one baby which includes diapers and baby milk powder. In the month of May, 19 babies received this care package. During the distribution, the GER SG team visited 15 homes, to hand out 19 care packages.

CARE FOR THE ELDERLY

5 Packages Distributed / 5 Beneficiaries

In June, GER SG started a new project to fundraise for the elderly in Singapore. The Ehsan For The Elderly project provides care packages for the beneficiaries which includes gift vouchers, adult diapers for those who are bed-ridden, gift baskets, and hot meals. 5 care packages were distributed to 5 elderly around Singapore.

GENERAL FOOD AID
