ACEH, INDONESIA EARTHQUAKE RELIEF

A 6.4 magnitude earthquake has struck off Pidie Jaya district, province of Aceh in Sumatra Island, Indonesia, around 05:00h local time, on 7 December 2016, killing at least 90 people and damaging more than 200 houses.



Sumatra has been struck by at least two strong earthquakes this year. They include a magnitude-5.9 quake on April 10 about 61km south-west of Bengkulu, and a powerful magnitude-7.8 earthquake about 800km off the coast of Padang on March 2.

Humanitarian aid is needed urgently to help the victims who are involved in Aceh Earthquake. Funds collected will support the search, rescue and retrieval efforts. The need to recover the fallen houses



SOMALIA CRISIS

In 2016, Somalia was affected by a Disease called Malnutrition. It is a sickness whereby some of the patient could not consumed food. It is not only affect adults and elderly but also could affect anyone and especially young children. Global Ehsan Relief had the opportunity to help with the disaster on 2016.

Malnutrition is a subnutrition occurs when an individual does not consume enough food. It may exist if the person has a poor diet that gives them the wrong balance of basic food groups. Poor diet may lead to a vitamin or mineral deficiency, among other essential substances, sometimes resulting in scurvy - a condition where an individual has a vitamin C deficiency.



Somalia is struggling with extreme climate conditions, where in the last two years, below average and erratic rainfall provoked severe droughts. There's 4.7 million people – nearly 40 percent of Somalia's population – are in need of humanitarian assistance.

The humanitarian situation in Somalia has become increasingly fragile towards the end of 2016, especially in the northern regions. Drought conditions are deepening in Puntland and Somaliland. The impact of the drought and the demand on humanitarian resources has been further magnified by a number of emerging crises, including an increase in conflict-related displacements and refugee returns from Kenya.



GLOBAL QURBAN 2016

It has been 2 years Global Ehsan Relief implement of Overseas Korban on Hari Raya Haji.

In various country such as Tanzania, Malawi, CAR, Rohingya, Kenya, Albania, Sri Lanka, Nepal, Afghanistan, Pakistan, Kashmir, Yemen, Bangladesh, Myanmar, Philippines, Senegal, Gambia, Aceh, Cambodia, Chechnya, Sudan, Syria, Palestine, Iraq and Bosnia.

This year not only sheep, goat and cow but also camel that will be given to the needy.

There is nothing dearer to Allah during the days of Eid al-Adha than the sacrificing of animals. The sacrificed animal shall come on the Day of judgment with its horns, hair, and hooves (to be weighed). The sacrifice is accepted by Allah before the blood reaches the ground. Therefore sacrifice with an open and happy heart. (Tirmizi, Ibne Majah)

Global Ehsan Relief together with its International partners, performs Qurban worldwide and we will make sure your sacrifice is done in the appropriate Islamic way and at the right time. We only use the healthiest Qurban animals (sheep, goat, cow, camels) and will deliver the fresh meat straight to those who need it the most.



WAQAF WATER WELL & HAND PUMP

What is Waqaf?

Waqaf is very unique and beneficial for poverty alleviation programmes. This project will portray the meaning and essential elements of a valid waqaf. Evolution of the concept of waqf and Various kinds of waqaf under Muslim law.

When a person who is working for charitable purpose under religious faith and sentiments and for the benefit and upliftment of the society, has donate his property in the name of Allah is called waqaf. Waqaf literally means 'detention' stop-page or tying up, meaning thereby that the ownership of dedicated property is taken away from the person making waqaf and transferred and detained by God. Details are given in old texts about waqaf made by prophet.

Where we build?

We fund water programs in 12 countries around the globe - in Africa, Asia, Central and South America. Water scarcity, poverty, political stability and strong partner organizations all play a part in where we choose to work. We focus on providing rural communities with their first access to clean water.

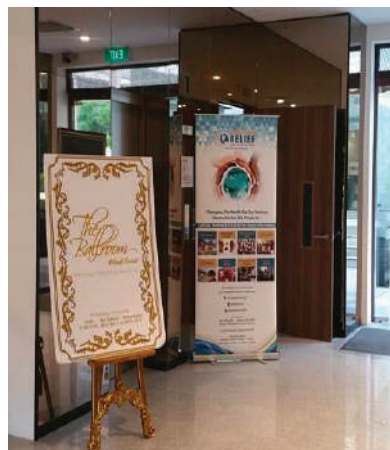
We're not just about funding new wells, we're also taking care of the ones we've already built. This is how we ensure that our water projects continue to provide clean water to communities long after they are installed. Pipeline is a system of local leaders, innovative technology and trained mechanics all working together to keep water flowing at charity: water projects around the world.

Through this waqaf well we're building wells in 4 countries, providing safe water to drink, wash and clean, to grow crops and to water animals. This can lead to healthier lives, a better chance to go to school or work and a route out of poverty. Wells can take six to nine months to be built, and we'll send you a feedback report so you can see your well and find out about the people it is supporting.
